



INTRODUCTION:

How delighted would you be to receive this little Gift Bag! Perfect for small gifts, make up or a selection of mini cards. You could personalise it – add a little ornament or designer tab to the side of the bag. So many ways to make it your own.

(NB: As you need 12" x 12" cardstock for this bag proportions, I suggest the following coordinating cardstocks for the Delightful Daisy Designer Series Paper.

Night of Navy – Regals Best 145407

Tranquil Tide – In Color 12" x 12" cardstock 145453

Daffodil Delight – Brights Best 145409

Whisper White – 124302

SUPPLIES: - Tote Bag

Paper (including cutting dimensions)

- Delightful Daily DSP 144137 - Main bag piece – $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12''$ – to make a deeper bag cut at $5'' \times 12''$
- Whisper White 12" x 12" cardstock 124302 – Bag base - $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$ – Score all four sides at $\frac{1}{2}''$ and snip all four corners, once only, to make corners of box.
- Whisper White - Bottom Strip/Band – $\frac{3}{4}'' \times 12''$
- Whisper White - Top Strip/Band – $\frac{3}{4}'' \times 12''$
- Whisper White - Inside Strip/Band – $\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12''$ (suggestion - this might actually be better done in Night of Navy)
- Whisper White - Inside Designer Label – $3'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$
- Handles (2 of) – $\frac{3}{4}'' \times 8''$ for 5" bag make handle length 12"
- Side Loops (2 of) – $3'' \times \frac{3}{8}''$
- Between Handle Strip/Band (2 of) – $\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1\frac{5}{8}''$

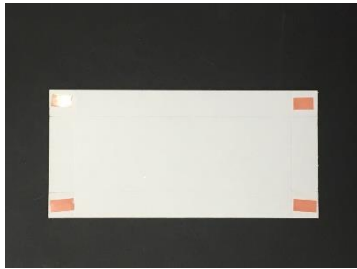

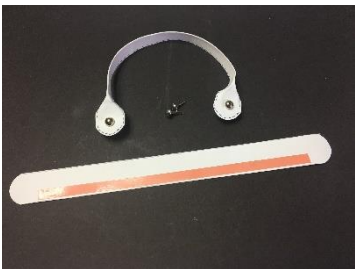
1 - Cut Bag Base and score all 4 sides at 1/2"

2 - Cut corner to make in to a box shape.

3 - Cut Main Bag Piece from DSP and apply adhesive as illustrated.

4 - With the adhesive to the bottom, wrap the Main Bag Piece around the Bag Base to create the bag shape.

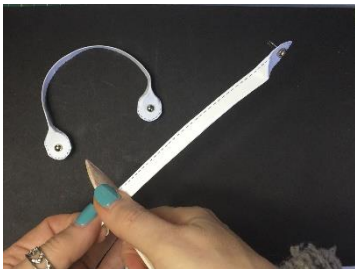
5 - Keep in mind to ensure all seams are at the middle/back.



6 - Using marker, draw in faux stitching to the top and bottom strips and adhere to the bag.

7 - With circle punch, trim off both ends of the 2 handle pieces and draw faux stitching.

8 - Apply adhesive to the inside of the handle pieces (note that it doesn't go right to both ends) and fold in half **HOWEVER**, make sure to use your thumb to create the shape of the end of the handles.



9 - Using a bone folder, create a curve in the handles before attaching them to the bag with the brads. A piercing tool and piercing mat are useful at this stage.



10 - Use the marker to draw faux stitching on the inside strip. Carefully apply this inside the bag in such a position to cover the back of the brads. This can be a little tricky so take your time to position it carefully.

11 - Finish by stamping your 'designer label' on to Whisper White cardstock and punching out with the Tab Circle Punch. Create a little faux stitching in this also, then adhere to inside of bag.

12 - To finish, apply faux stitching to the remaining 2 little 'between handle' strips. Fold them in two and adhere them to the top front/back of the bag.
